

Emergency Evacuation Plan



In the event of an emergency requiring evacuation of the facility, proceed to Assembly Point A (west end of the parking lot) located outside the danger zone. If primary Assembly Point A is inaccessible due to the emergency, report to Assembly Point B (east end of the parking lot). Remain in the assembly area until roll call is taken and the all clear is given by the proper authority. Any missing person shall be reported to the Incident Commander/supervisor in charge. Under no circumstance do we re-enter the facility until we have been given the all clear from the emergency response team (Incident Commander), Fire Department, or the supervisor in charge of the incident.





Emergency Evacuation Plan

In the event of an emergency required evacuation of the building, proceed to **Assembly Point A** located outside the danger zone. If the primary Assembly Point A is inaccessible due to the emergency, report to **Assembly Point B**. Remain in a group with others until the person in charge does a head count to verify all people are accounted for.

Any persons missing will be reported immediately to the person in charge.

If you have any information about an injured or missing employee, relay that to the person in charge.

Under no circumstances do we re-enter a facility until we have been given the all clear from the emergency team, Fire Department or department in charge of the evacuation.

Severe Weather

If severe weather threatens or the Civil Defense sirens sound, follow these procedures:

- Proceed calmly to the northwest storage room Severe Weather Shelter on the 1st floor,
 - Northwest corner of the building.
- Remain in the severe weather shelter until the weather passes and the supervisor gives the "All-Clear".
